Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met today to review the ongoing non-Indian commercial fisheries and took the following actions:

Non-Indian Fisheries

Fall Chinook Commercial Fishery

- Modified the previously non-Indian commercial fishery. Modification in **bold**.

Season: 8 PM Tuesday August 25 to 6 AM Wednesday August 26 (10 hrs)
 8 PM Thursday August 27 to 6 AM Friday August 28 (10 hrs)

Area: **Zone 5.**

Allowable Salmon and white sturgeon (43-54 inch fork length).

Sales:

A maximum of **three** white sturgeon may be possessed or sold by each participating vessel during each calendar week (Sunday through Saturday) of the open fishing periods. The **three** white sturgeon possession and sales limit includes **both mainstem and Select Area fisheries.**

- All sanctuaries, gear, miscellaneous regulations and reporting rule presented in the July 29, 2009 Columbia River Fishery Notice remain unchanged.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- The Joint staff will continue to monitor all ongoing fisheries and schedule additional hearings as necessary.
