Compact Action

The Columbia River Compact agencies of Oregon and Washington met yesterday and took the following actions:

Treaty Fisheries

- Closed the main-stem Zone 6 platform and hook-and-line fishery to commercial sales of all species effective 6 PM Friday October 15, 2009. The platform and hook and line fishery will remain open for subsistence use under all other existing regulations.
- Effective 6 PM Friday October 15, 2009 a Yakama Nation Transfer Permit is required for the commercial sale of fish caught in the Klickitat and Drano Lake Yakama Nation tributary fisheries.

FUTURE MEETINGS

- A Compact hearing is scheduled for 3 PM Monday October 19, 2009 via teleconference to review salmon stock status and ongoing fisheries.
